Your child will learn all about water conservation, horticulture, wildlife
and nutrition through hands-on activities.*

Little Learners Camp is for children entering first, second or third grade. This camp features an introduction to basic environmental principles. Children will learn the importance of saving water, what plants need to grow, why nutrition matters and the benefits of wildlife.

STEAM Camp is for children entering fourth, fifth or sixth grade. This camp features an in-depth exploration into STEAM. Children will learn how science, technology, art and mathematics shape the environment around us.

Registration

Registration for both weeks of camp will open Wednesday, May 1st, 2019 and will close Friday, May 31st, 2019. Access the registration form on our Facebook page or on our website.

Documents

The only documents required through Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful are a liability waiver and photo release. You will sign both of these documents at drop-off on the first day of camp.



Activities

Over the course of the week, campers will master environmental concepts in our interactive Florida Learning Garden. Campers will build a watershed model, plant seeds and seedlings, propagate plants, collect and examine insects, harvest fresh produce and learn how to create a healthy snack in the garden.

Staff & Counselors

Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful staff and UF/IFAS Extension Agents will be on site at all times for Summer Camp. Our camp staff members are qualified environmental professionals. Staff members hold certifications in First Aid/CPR/AED. Our youth counselors are Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful Ambassadors.

Location & Facility

All five days of camp will take place at the Florida Learning Garden, a project of Keep Tampa Bay Beautiful in partnership with the Florida State Fair Authority. This garden is a one-acre interactive space, featuring Florida-friendly walking trails, pollinator gardens, hydroponics, a greenhouse, raised garden beds, chicken coop, and compost bins.

Meals & Health Restrictions

Local restaurants sponsor the Florida Learning Garden Summer Camp by generously providing lunch each day for the campers. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate for health and dietary restrictions; therefore, if your child has any allergies or restrictions, please pack an appropriate lunch for your child.
